B. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR SENIOR COLLEGE PROGRAM

A completed A.S. degree in Early Childhood Education at BMCC, with the following additional requirements:

- Grade of B or better in English Composition I, its equivalent, or any course designated as writing intensive
- Successful completion of one college-level mathematics course – Math 214
- For direct admission into City College’s Bachelor of Science Early Childhood Program, students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.00 or better from the entire college/postsecondary school academic history
- Applicants must pass the CCNY School of Education SEAT exam
- Applicants must participate in a group interview at CCNY, Center for Worker Education and provide an on-site writing sample and an up-to-date resume
- Accepted students must declare a major in Early Childhood Education and a Liberal Arts Co-concentration
- Students who major in Education must meet liberal arts requirements for New York State teaching certification. All of these requirements can be met with Pathways categories, but not all Pathways courses meet State certification requirements.
