# A. SENDING AND RECEIVING INSTITUTIONS

Sending College: Borough of Manhattan Community College

Department: Business Management

<u>Program:</u> Business Management – Finance and Banking, General Management, or Marketing Concentration

<u>Degree</u>: Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.)

Receiving College: Iona College

Department: Management, Business Administration, & Health Care Management;

Finance, Business Economics, & Legal Studies; and

Marketing & International Business

Program: Bachelor of B.B.A.in Management, Finance, or Marketing

<u>Degree</u>: Bachelor of Business Administration (B.B.A.)

### B. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR SENIOR COLLEGE PROGRAM

Borough of Manhattan Community College (BMCC) students who graduate with an A.A.S. degree in the specified program above and who have achieved a cumulative GPA of 2.5, with all courses taken at BMCC, will be eligible for a maximum of 60 transfer credits. Students must satisfy all degree requirements, including prerequisites, at Iona College.

# C. IONA COLLEGE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR TRANSFER

1. Qualified BMCC graduates will have all courses evaluated in light of the most useful credits in transfer for a maximum of 60 credits. Credits will be evaluated for use in major, minor, college core, degree core, co- and prerequisites, and electives, as applicable.

- 2. Courses evaluated and accepted for transfer to Iona College will receive full credit as awarded by BMCC, regardless of a difference in course credit value at Iona College.
- 3. Each transferring student will meet with the designated transfer credit evaluator in the dean's office of the designated School at Iona College, who will clarify and chart initial progress toward degree completion. Subsequent to this first advisement meeting, each transfer student will be directed to the chairperson of the department of the chosen major at which time the student will be advised with a program plan for graduation. The program plan will illustrate how to complete the degree chosen, with every effort made to ensure timely degree completion usually two years of full-time study or its part-time equivalent.
- 4. All students transferring to Iona College are accountable for academic policy and procedure related to admission to the College, declaration of major/minor, and degree completion, as specified in the Iona College Undergraduate Catalog at the time of entry and at the time of official declaration of major as appropriate. Students must satisfy all degree requirements at Iona College.

- □ Transfer students seeking degrees in the specific program covered by this agreement will need to meet the requirements outlined in this document.
- □ Both BMCC and Iona College agree to keep each other informed of program changes in a timely way.

#### G. ARTICULATION AGREEMENT FOLLOW-UP PROCEDURES

- 1. Procedures for reviewing, updating, modifying or terminating agreement:

  When either of the degree programs involved in this agreement undergoes a change, the agreement will be reviewed and revised accordingly by faculty from each institution's respective departments, selected by their Chairpersons and/or program directors.
- 2. Procedures for evaluating agreement, i.e., tracking the number of students who transfer under the articulation agreement and their success:
  - Each semester, Iona College will provide BMCC with the following information: a) the number of BMCC students who applied to the program; b) the number of BMCC students who were accepted into the program; c) the number of BMCC students who enrolled; and d) the aggregate GPA of these enrolled students.
- 3. Sending and receiving college procedures for publicizing agreement, e.g., college catalogs, transfer advisers, Websites, etc.:
  - This articulation agreement will be publicized on the BMCC website and on Iona College's website. Transfer advisors at BMCC will promote this agreement with eligible students.
- 4. Student Recruitment:

BMCC will provide opportunities for Iona College to recruit BMCC graduates through table events, information sessions, on-the-spot admissions, and other such advisement events. On Iona's behalf, BMCC will send out communication to eligible students who may be interested in attending Iona College upon graduation. In turn, Iona College will provide BMCC with information on students who applied to and were denied admissions to Iona College.

# H. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION (E.G., FINANCIAL AID, TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIPS)

Iona College is committed to dedicating specific scholarships to BMCC students accepted through this articulation agreement. Scholarship programs available include: Transfer Scholarship awards, Iona Celtic Scholarship awards, Alpha Beta Gamma Scholarship awards, and Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship awards. Scholarships will be award to students in accordance with Iona College policies. Scholarship programs are subject to change on an annual basis.
