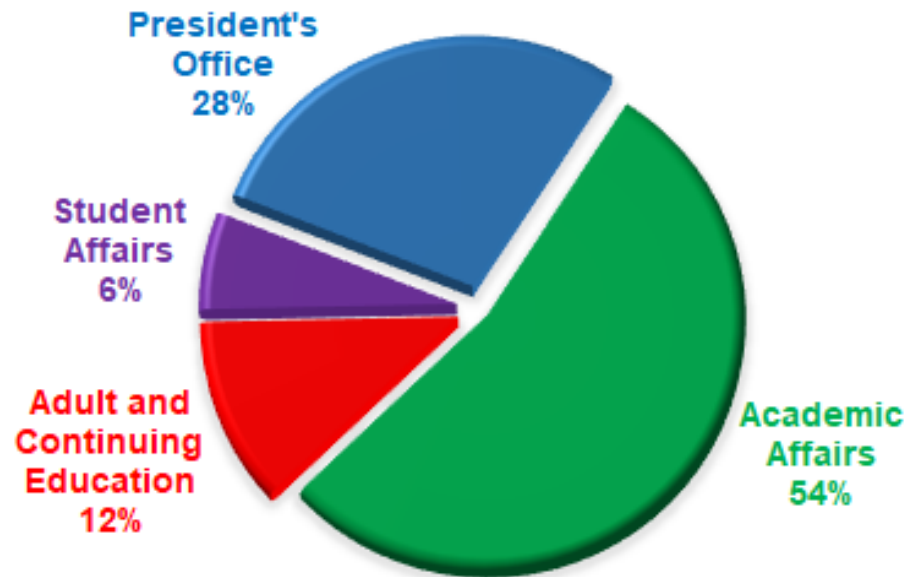

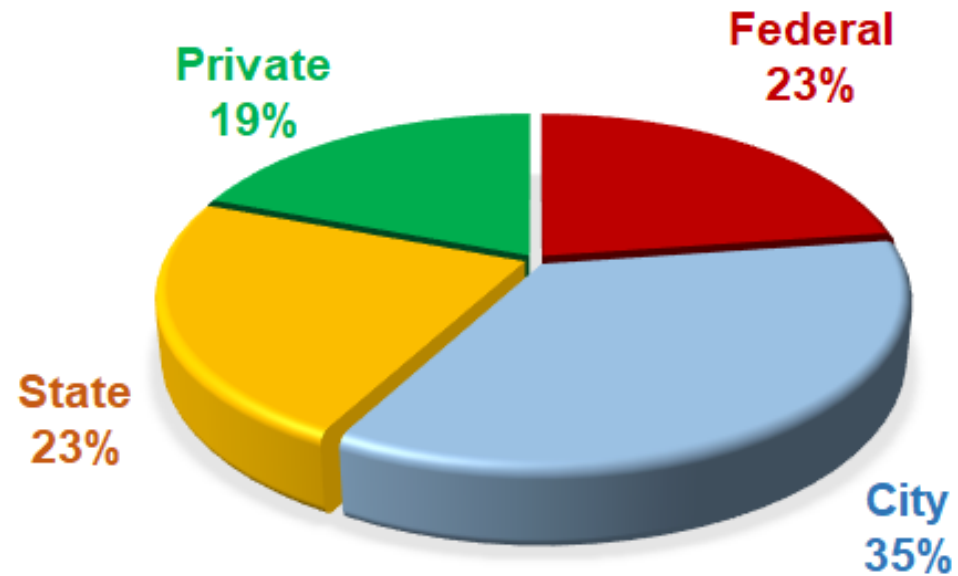
## Distribution of Funding by Sector 2019 - 2020

## Distribution of Funding Sources for FY 2019-20

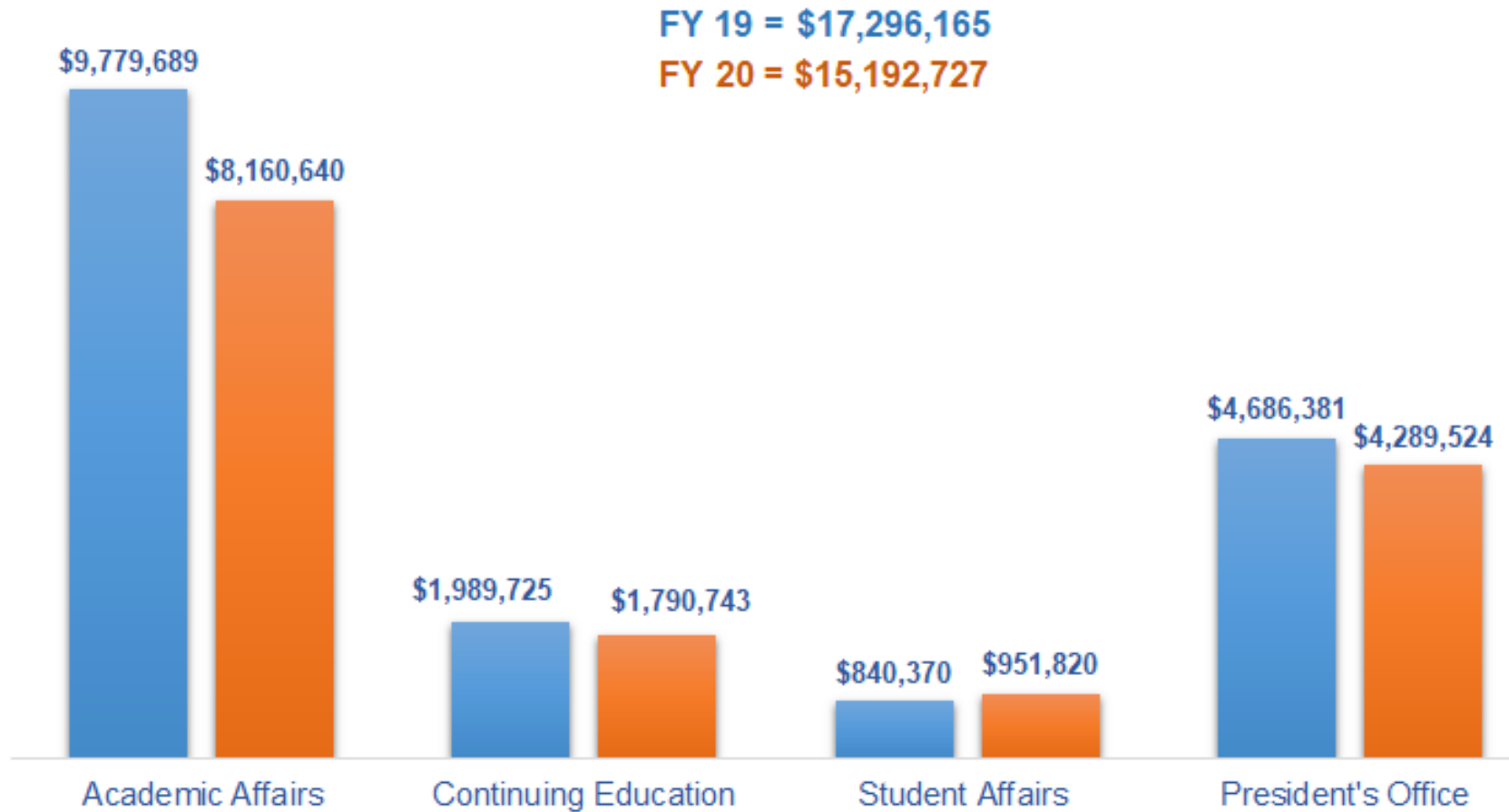

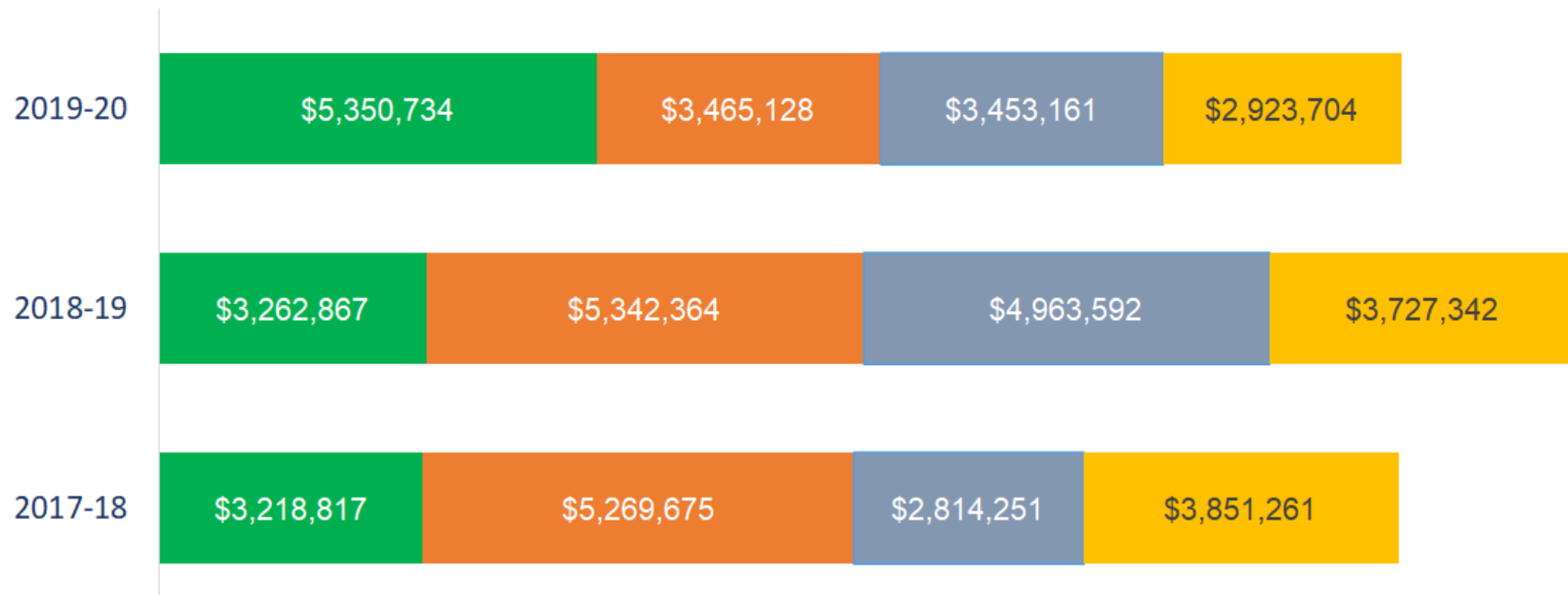
## Two Year Comparison by Sector



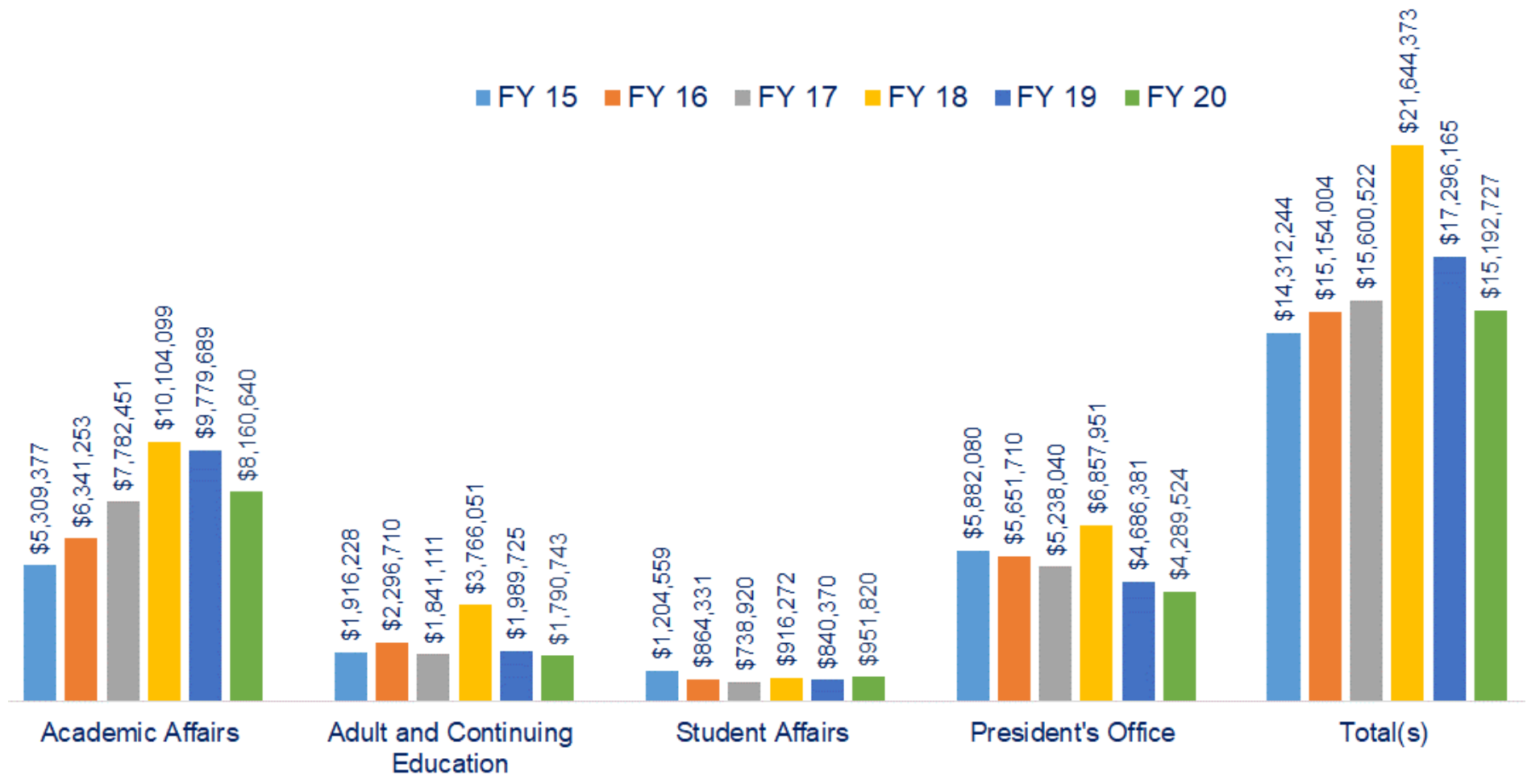
## Three-Year Comparison of Funding Sources FY 17 - FY20



■ City      ■ State      ■ Federal      ■ Private

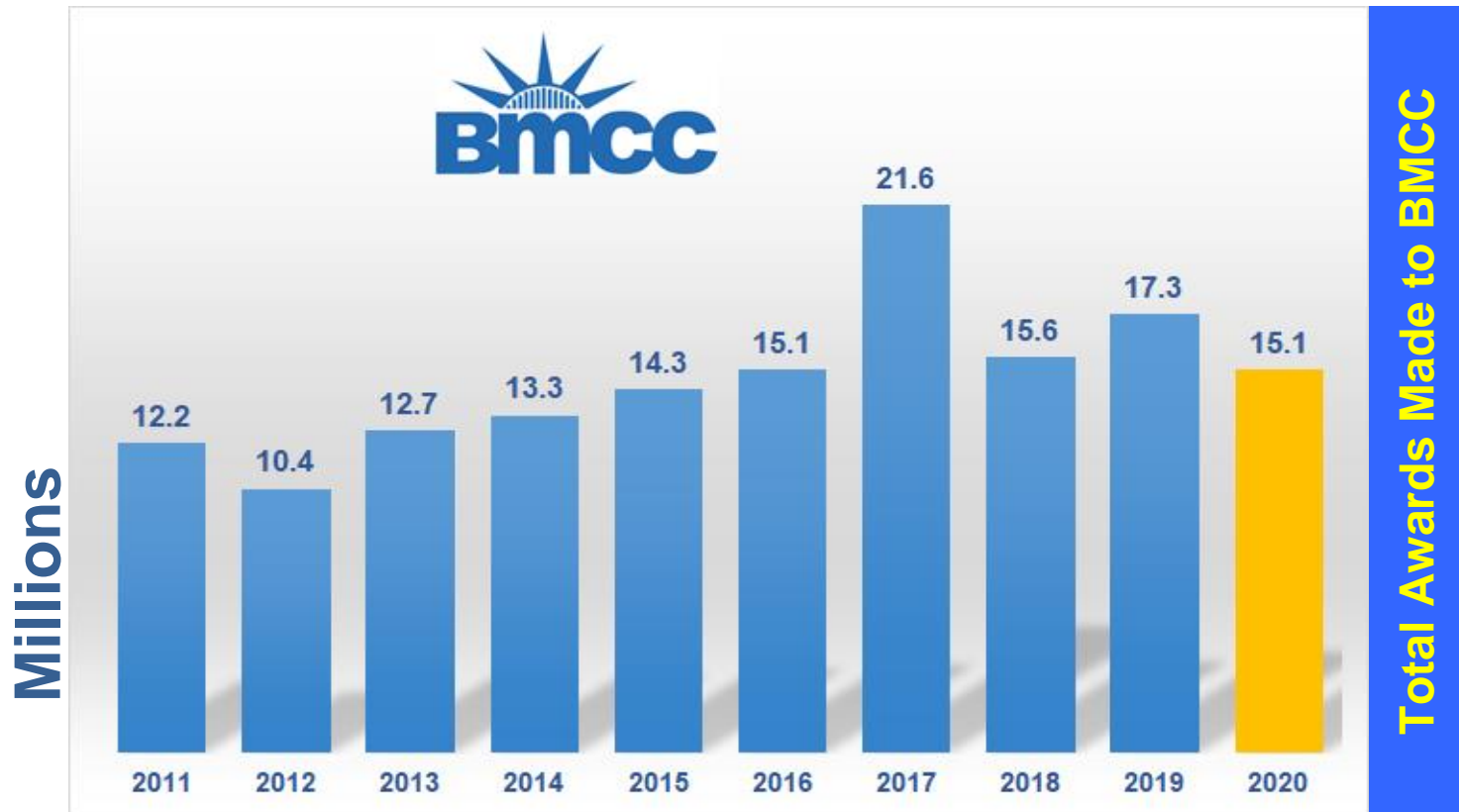


## Six-Year Comparison of Awards by Area FY 15 – FY 20
