Job Responsibilities:

- Discuss assigned duties with Lead Instructor to coordinate instructional efforts
- Assist Lead Instructor with supervision of class
- Assign resources to students based upon deficiencies in skill competencies
- Tutor and assist students individually or in small groups to help them master assignments and to reinforce learning concepts presented by Lead Instructor.
- Grade homework and tests, and compute and record results, using answer sheets or electronic marking devices (when applicable)
- Observe students' performance, and record relevant data to assess progress
- Distribute teaching materials to students
- Distribute tests and homework assignments, and collect them when they are completed
- Maintain the same high level of ethical behavior and confidentiality of information about students as is expected of teachers
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships
- Follow all rules, policies and procedures outlined by The Borough of Manhattan Community College.
- Enforce ACE administration policies and rules governing students
- Comfortable teaching groups in break out rooms
- Contributes to program outcomes by accomplishing related duties and responsibilities as requested by the Lead Instructor.
