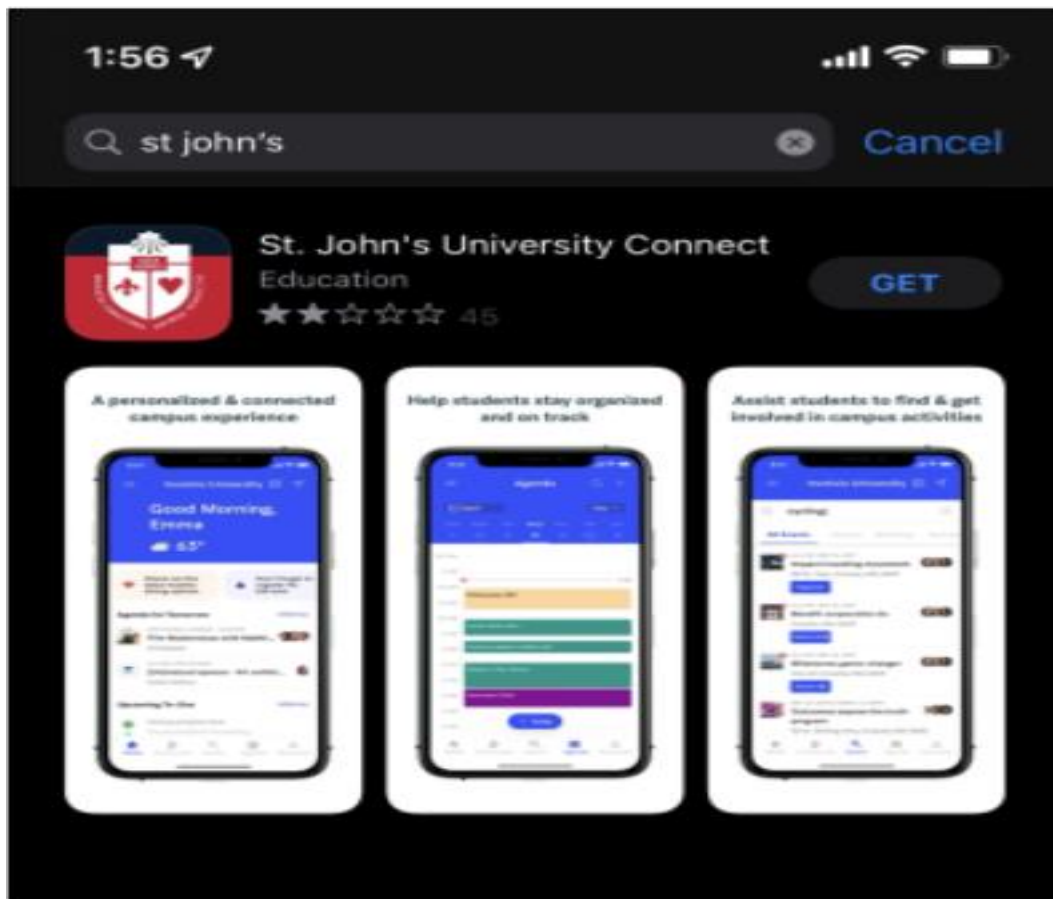
COVID Safety Policy
