viii. New Course: LIN 140 - World/Global Englishes

- 1. **Description**: Create a course that introduces students to the study of the variety of Englishes around the world theory, societal forces, attitudes and impact. It is an elective in the Linguistics and Literacy program. This course is also proposed in the World Cultures and Global Issues bucket of Pathways Flexible Core.

ix. New Course: LIN 150 - Language Race and Ethnicity in the US and its Territories

- 1. **Description**: Create a course that explores the relationship between language, race and ethnicity in the US and use language as a means to examine topics related to race and ethnicity. It is an elective in the Linguistics and Literacy program. This course is also proposed in the US Experiences in its Diversity bucket of Pathways Flexible Core.
