Minutes of the Academic Standing Committee of the Academic Senate

Meeting of February 6, 2019

- The meeting was convened by Glenn Miller, Chair, at 2:00 p.m. in room N-795.
- Committee members read and acted on student appeals.
- Minutes from 11-7-2018 and 12-5-2018 were unanimously approved.
- Glenn Miller, Chair, reported that a total of 1,214 appeals were read by this committee in January, 2019 (reinstatements, grade changes, and financial aid); committed approved 80.3% reinstatements; 92.9% grade changes, and 79.7% financial aid.
- Committee discussed a proposal to consider appeals for NC grades for eligible students who wish to receive an NC grade but did not opt-in before the official deadline.
 - o Motion was made by Glenn Miller proposing that the Committee on Academic Standing consider such appeals with the course instructor's consent.
 - Motion was seconded
 - o Committee voted: 10 in favor; zero opposed
- Anthony Creaco, ASC Executive Representative, announced that he had confirmed with the Director of Academic Advisement and Transfer, Carei Thomas, that the new policy of considering academic appeals after three or more dismissals will be reflected in the next edition of the BMCC College Catalog for the 2019-2020 academic year.
- Cynthia Wiseman inquired about the status of an on-line process for reading and acting on student appeals; Glenn Miller indicated that we might have prototype this semester so that the Appeals Committee can test the on-line system.
- The meeting was adjourned at 3:30 p.m.
