



#### ARTICULATION AGREEMENT FORM

## B. Partnership Information & Admissions Requirements

Empire State College (ESC), of the State University of New York, and Borough of Manhattan Community College (BMCC), of the City University of New York, agree to a Pathways\* Transfer Agreement in Nursing. The agreement is designed to support transfer students during their transition to ESC, and intends to:

- ensure a smooth transfer for BMCC graduates to ESC;
- ease the transition process for graduates changing from classroom-based learning to an educational model comprised significantly of online coursework;
- provide an affordable and convenient baccalaureate degree option for BMCC graduates who want to remain close to their homes and/or community; and
- provide clear guidelines for BMCC graduates to follow during the transition.

ESC will offer A.A.S degree graduates in nursing from BMCC an opportunity to participate in the Pathways Transfer Program into the B.S.N. degree in nursing program. BMCC graduates meeting ESC's admissions requirements will become ESC students upon admission.

#### Admissions Requirements

- Completed A.A.S degree in nursing;
- Possession of an active, unencumbered nursing license (RN);
- Completed ESC admissions application (including essay).

<sup>\*</sup>Pathways: "Pathways" in this document refers to ESC Transfer Partnership program, not the City University of New York General Education framework.

While enrolled at ESC, students in the Pathways Program may cross-register for up to 16 credits at BMCC. These lower-division credits will be applicable to general education requirements in the baccalaureate degree program. The minimum number of credits to be taken at ESC would be at least 45 advanced-level credits, which would include 41 credits in nursing. Up to 79 total credits could be included from BMCC. Each participating student will be able to transfer all credits earned as part of their associate's degree to Empire State College as long as they fit into the student's designed bachelor's degree program.

Nursing students may enroll at ESC on a full or part-time basis.

Demand for this program is expected to be high. Students from BMCC who are interested in the RN to BSN program are welcome to apply and will be considered as space is available. The transfer conditions are applicable to all admitted students.

### C. Transfer Credit Awarded

BMCC graduates who complete the A.A.S. degree in Nursing will receive 65 credits toward the Bachelor of Science B.S.N. degree in nursing at ESC.

<sup>\*</sup>CHE 121 (4 credits) is the prerequisite for BIO 425 at BMCC. Two credits satisfy the general elective requirement. Students who complete CHE 121 (4 credits) will have the 2 additional credits transfer to ESC. These credits will satisfy two of the 18 required credits in the General Learning Component. In this case, a total of 67 credits will be transferred from BMCC and students will need to complete an additional 57 credits to earn the BSN degree.
