F. AGREEMENT FOLLOW-UP PROCEDURES

1. Procedures for reviewing, updating, modifying or terminating agreement:

When either of the degree programs involved in this agreement undergoes a change, the agreement will be reviewed and revised accordingly by faculty from each institution's respective departments or programs, selected by their Chairpersons and/or program directors.

2. Procedures for evaluating agreement (i.e., tracking the number of students who transfer under the articulation agreement and their success):

Each year York College will provide Borough of Manhattan Community College (BMCC) with the following information: a) the number of BMCC graduates who applied to the program; b) the number of BMCC students who were accepted into the program; c) and the number of BMCC students who enrolled; d) the aggregate GPA of these enrolled students at York

- 3. Sending and receiving college procedures for publicizing agreement (e.g., college catalogs, transfer advisers, websites, etc.):
 - This articulation agreement will be publicized on both the BMCC website and the York College website.
 - Transfer advisors at BMCC will promote this agreement with eligible students.
