- 1. Reviewed and accepted minutes from previous meeting
- 2. Open Discussion on the setting a credit limit to serve on SGA
 - Harry Mars presented a motion to set a 56 credit limit to serve on SGA
 - Second by Professor Levy.
 - Discussion included:
 - o This issue was mentioned during the SGE presidential debate
 - o SGA eligibility parameters set by CUNY, BMCC, and SGA were explained showing that not all student are eligible to serve on SGA.
 - o Data from the last 6 SGA was presented to show the effect of this matter.
 - Examples of other CUNY schools with upper end credit limits for serving were presented.
 - Data showed that many students serving on SGA have graduated prior to or during their term.
 - o Those students running for SGA with more than 56 credits averaged almost 67 credits earned.
 - The average number of earned credits for graduates during this time was between 66-67 credits.
 - Ouestion was called.
 - Motion was passed 5-3 to bring to College Council for approval.

 - Dr. Barrios would like to bring up the conversation regarding military transfer credit review.
