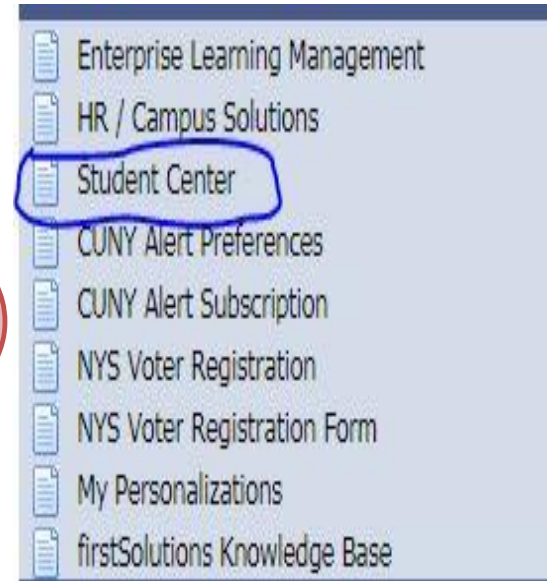

# CUNYfirst Functions: Admissions

- CUNYfirst can be used for:
  - Transfer Credit Status
  - Grades (Unofficial Transcripts)
  - Holds (ADM, ADV)



# CUNYfirst Functions: Health Services

- Immunization Records
  - MMR Hold = must bring proof of immunizations
  - MEN Hold = acknowledgement of meningitis form – can be completed in CUNYfirst

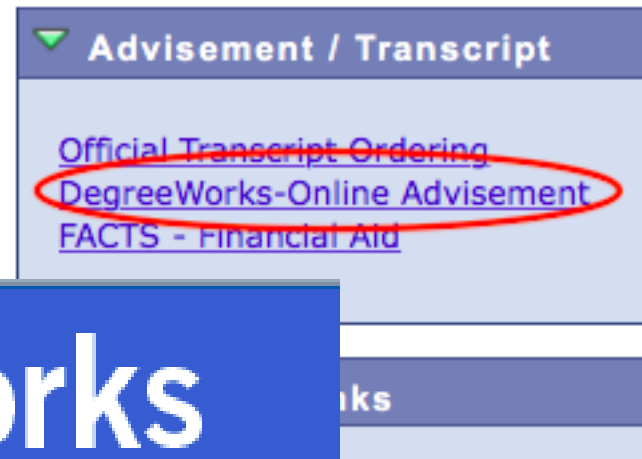

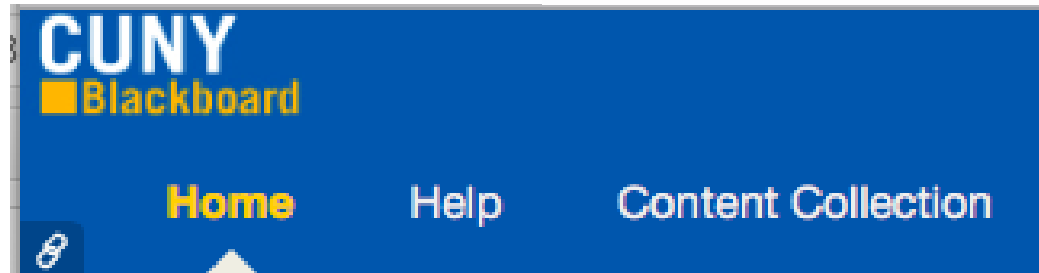
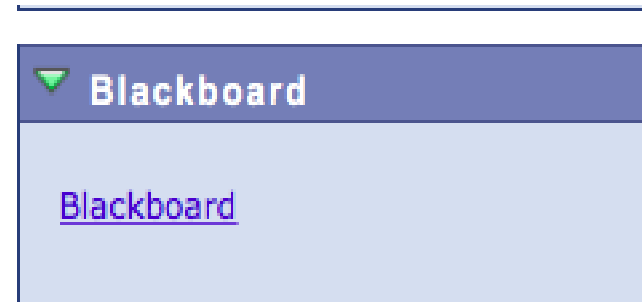

## BMCC Portal Account

BMCC Portal is an online all-access point for applications and resources. Through the BMCC Portal, you can gain access to Panther, student email, Federal Work Study information, Library Databases, CUNY Portal and links to frequently used pages on the BMCC Web site. The Portal also includes a Password Lockbox where you can store all of your BMCC related passwords for single sign-on access to BMCC accounts. 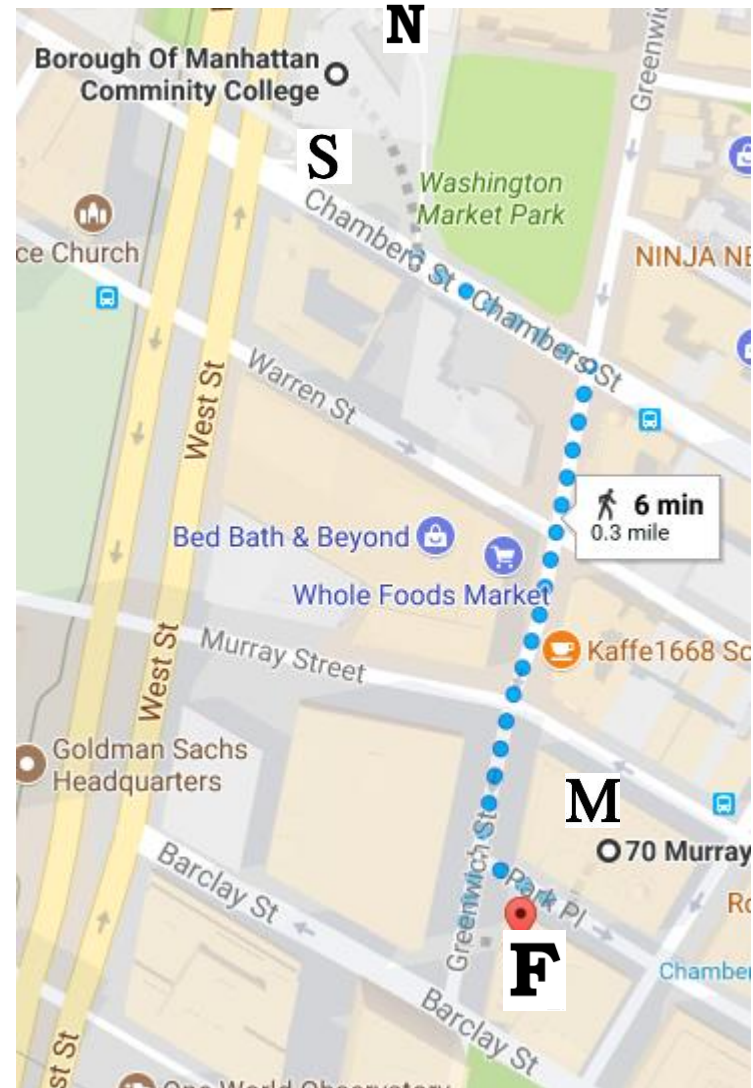

# GPA Calculation: Example

Course	Final Grade	Quality Points	Credits	Points Earned
ENG 101	D	1	3	3
MAT 150	A-	3.7	4	14.8
MES 100	B+	3.3	3	9.9
SPE 100	A	4	3	12
THE 100	B	3	3	9
	Totals	15	16	48.7

$$\text{GPA} = \text{Points Earned} / \text{Total Credits Attempted}$$
$$= 48.7 / 16 = 3.04$$

**Grade Point Average = 3.04**

# GPA Calculation: WU GRADE IMPACT

Course	Final Grade	Quality Points	Credits	Points Earned
ENG 101	D	1	3	3

	Totals	11.3	16	33.9

$$\text{GPA} = \text{Points Earned} / \text{Total Credits Attempted}$$
$$= 33.9 / 16 = 2.11$$

**Grade Point Average = 2.11**

# W grades affect F-1 status:

## VIOLATION

WU – Withdrew Unofficially

WN – Never Attended

WA – Administrative Withdrawal

W – Withdrew between 4<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> week

\*W grades in a class = F-1 students cannot use the class credits towards 12-credit minimum to maintain status

# Tuition Payment Options

**Finalizing your bill can be done in more ways than one!**

- 1. Tuition Pay Plan** – Payments through the CUNY payment plan can be made by eCheck or credit card. The earlier you enroll in the plan, the lower your monthly installment amounts. An enrollment fee is charged by the payment plan vendor.
- 2. Third Party Voucher** – For students who have an employer or government entity (for scholarship) submitting tuition payment on behalf of the student.
- 3. Cash, Check, Money Order** – Bursar's Office is in Room S330 and can accept these types of payments. Payments can also be made online in CUNYfirst via eCheck.
