



Tuition Payment Options

Finalizing your bill can be done in more ways than one!

- 1. Tuition Pay Plan Payments through the CUNY payment plan can be made by eCheck or credit card. The earlier you enroll in the plan, the lower your monthly installment amounts. An enrollment fee is charged by the payment plan vendor.
- 2. Third Party Voucher For students who have an employer or government entity (for scholarship) submitting tuition payment on behalf of the student.
- 3. Cash, Check, Money Order Bursar's Office is in Room S330 and can accept these types of payments. Payments can also be made online in CUNYfirst via eCheck.
